

As you can see from the below Google Search trendlines (link <u>here</u>), "Temecula wine" (yellow) has drawn more user searches than "Santa Barbara wine" (blue) for at least the past ten years. And it was in 2018 that "Paso Robles wine" (red) overtook "Santa Barbara wine" and the gap continues to widen.



Santa Barbara's share of consumer mindshare is losing ground and we need to reverse this trend. It is critical our region be able to compete with these other regions lest we fall into irrelevancy in the marketplace with a negative countywide impact.
