The department has unanticipated revenue of \$219,900 in Intergovernmental Revenue-State including: \$107,500 in Public Safety Prop 172 Sales Tax; \$82,700 in

Vehicle License Fees; \$24,400 in SB90 Mandates; and \$5,300 in AB109 realignment funds. In addition, the department has expenditure savings of \$265,100

in Salaries & Benefits due to unfilled vacancies and Deputy District Attorney Association employee concessions. Fund balance will be used to mitigate service

level impacts in FY 2012-13 and FY 2013-14.

Budget Action: Increase appropriations of \$120,302 in General County Programs General Fund for Salaries and Benefits \$57,400 and Committed Fund Balance \$62,902

funded by unanticipated revenue from SBCERS replacement benefits funding.

Justification: In September 2004 the County of Santa Barbara Board of Supervisors adopted a County Replacement Benefits Plan. This was due to federal internal

revenue code provisions enacted in the 1990's. The code section provided a general dollar limit that restricts the amount of retirement benefits an IRS qualified plan can pay and applies to SBCERs and County retirement benefits. This budget revision establishes the budget for these replacement benefits of

\$57,400 and commits the remaining balance (\$62,902) of revenue received from SBCERs to fund balance for future expenditures.

unanticipated revenues from grants, vehicle offsets, operating transfers, increased fees and taxes, and release of committed fund balance from General

County Programs.

Justification: This budget revision adjusts revenue and expenditures in the County Executive Office in preparation for FY 11-12 year-end. Revenues are increased by a net

amount of \$186,456 (primarily Office of Emergency Management (OEM) \$181,000), offset by increased expenditures of \$84,000 and increases to fund balance of \$103,000. This will allow the CEO to pay for current year expenditures and rebudget OEM projects until FY 12-13. This BRR also reimburses

Public Works \$7,000 for the Tunnel Road signage project as well as pays for the Board workshop at the EOC and the EOC-GIS training using unanticipated

Nuclear Preparedness Plan and excess Energy revenue.
