

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

**IN THE MATTER OF ESTABLISHING)
TEMPORARY PARKING RESTRICTIONS)
AND ROAD CLOSURES DURING) RESOLUTION NO.
THE EVENT KNOWN AS “DELTOPIA”)
IN ISLA VISTA IN THE)
THIRD SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT)**

WHEREAS, Section 942.5(a) of the California Streets and Highways Code authorizes the Board of Supervisors of the County to restrict the use of, or close, any county road whenever the Board considers such closing or restriction necessary for the protection of the public; and

WHEREAS, No liability shall attach to the County, or to the Board of Supervisors, for the restriction of use, or closing, of any county road for the protection of the public; and

WHEREAS, Section 942.6 of the California Streets and Highways Code allows the Board of Supervisors of the County to delegate the powers contained in Section 942.5 to the County Road Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of public safety that certain portions of County streets or highways in the Isla Vista area in Santa Barbara County be closed or restricted during activities in Isla Vista for the event known as “Deltopia” or any other named unpermitted large events;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that the County of Santa Barbara Board of Supervisors hereby delegates to the County Road Commissioner the authority to exercise the powers contained in Section 942.5(a) of the California Streets and Highways Code between the dates of March 15 and April 30 each year within the community of Isla Vista during ‘Deltopia’ activities or other comparable large, unpermitted spring events.
