The 2025 California Energy Code takes significant steps toward requiring new buildings (and additions and alterations) to become all-electric. Starting on January 1, 2026, the 2025 Code will require:

- Single Family:
 - Both space and water heating systems be all-electric for single family homes
 - All-electric water heaters for additions and alterations
- Multifamily:
 - Individual unit water heaters to be all-electric
 - Instantaneous gas water heaters be no longer allowed
 - Electric readiness required for gas-fired central hot water and in-unit systems
- Nonresidential:
 - All-electric space conditioning for office and school buildings
 - All-electric space conditioning for additions and alterations
- Pools/Spas:
 - All-electric (gas back up allowed) or gas with 60% solar thermal/recovered energy fraction
