Summary Text:

The Board approved the award of the contract for the Tajiguas Landfill Phase IIA Groundwater Protection System on April 15, 2008. The project was completed within the contract period and was accepted as complete on December 12, 2009.

Background:

This project was the third phase of an eight phase expansion at the Tajiguas Landfill and is included in the Resource Recovery & Waste Management Division's Revised Solid Waste Facility Permit issued in May of 2003. The first phase was completed in 2004 and the final phase is projected to be completed in fiscal year 2013/14.
