My husband and I manage a mobilehome park in Old Orcutt. We have had the pleasure of working with Waste Management for many years through a commercial account. At the beginning of May, we had to transition all our residents to individual residential accounts because of the changes in legislation last year. Transitioning 229 senior homes all at once to residential service is no small feat. Waste Management was extremely helpful through the entire process.
