On November 29, 2022, the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors (Board) will conduct a public hearing to consider the adoption of amendments to the County Land Use and Development Code (LUDC), Montecito Land Use and Development Code (MLUDC), and Coastal Zoning Ordinance (Article II) to: revise the permitting and development standards for childcare facilities, exempt certain electric vehicle (EV) charging stations (including hydrogen fueling stations) from requiring a zoning permit, and include minor amendments to correct and clarify existing regulations and ensure that the regulations keep pace with current trends, policies, and State law.

The Board hearing begins at 9:00 A.M. The order of items listed on the agenda is subject to change by the Clerk of the Board. 


