




# Historic Oil Production by Year in Santa Barbara County 1923-2000




## Historic Gas Production by Year in Santa Barbara County 1923-2000



Prior to 1958, onshore production data included gas extracted from State Tideland fields



In June 2004 fire ravaged the Gaviota Coast, denuding chaparral covered hillsides. Following the fire, drenching rains in October and into the new year caused flooding along the Gaviota Coast, and elsewhere. Here debris from burned hillsides clogged drainages of oil and gas facilities on the Gaviota Coast causing localized damage as it flowed to the sea.
