WHEREAS, Michael A. Glassow is retiring after forty years of distinguished service as a Professor of Anthropology at the University of California, Santa Barbara; and

WHEREAS, for more than forty years Michael Glassow has been instrumental in promoting the importance of archaeology and cultural resource management in California and the United States, and has advocated tirelessly for the development of high archaeological standards, ethics, and conservation principles; and

WHEREAS, Michael Glassow joined the Department of Anthropology at UCSB in 1969, where he has been heavily involved in academic archaeology, cultural resource management, museum studies, and the conservation and preservation of California archaeological sites; and

WHEREAS, Michael's distinguished career includes directing the Museum of Anthropology at UCSB since 1969, serving as regional coordinator for the California Central Coast Information Center since 1975 and also serving as President of the Society for California Archaeology in 1988-89; and

WHEREAS, Michael Glassow served as Associate Editor for the Journal of California and Great Basin Anthropology from 1993 to 2000, was instrumental in establishing the Proceedings of the Society for California Archaeology, and was an Associate Editor for the Proceedings of the Sixth California Islands Conference;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors and commends Michael A. Glassow for a lifetime of promoting the importance of Archaeological study, and for inspiring countless students to pursue their academic dreams.
