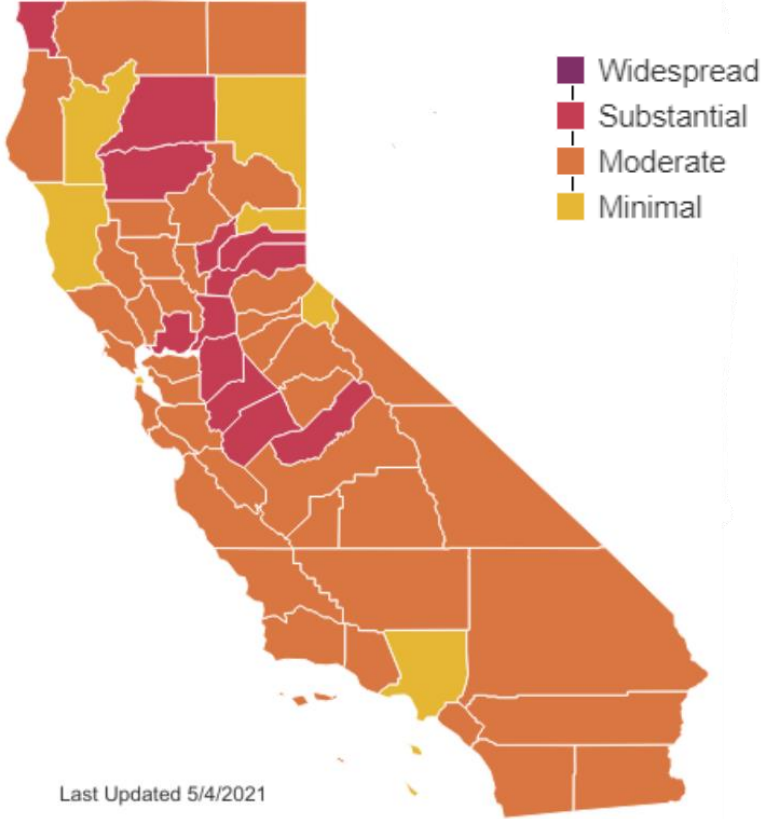

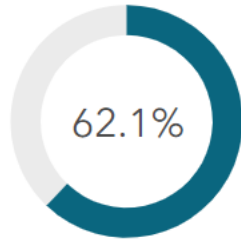

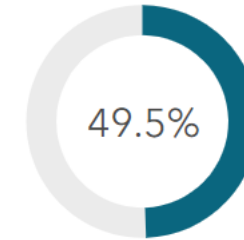


Vaccination Rates, as of May 9th

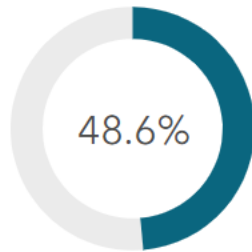
% of Eligible SB Individuals Vaccinated
(Eligible persons 16+ years old, first or single dose)



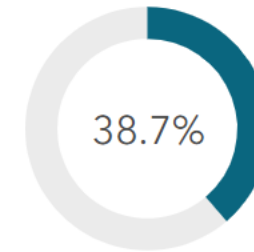
% of SB County Vaccinated

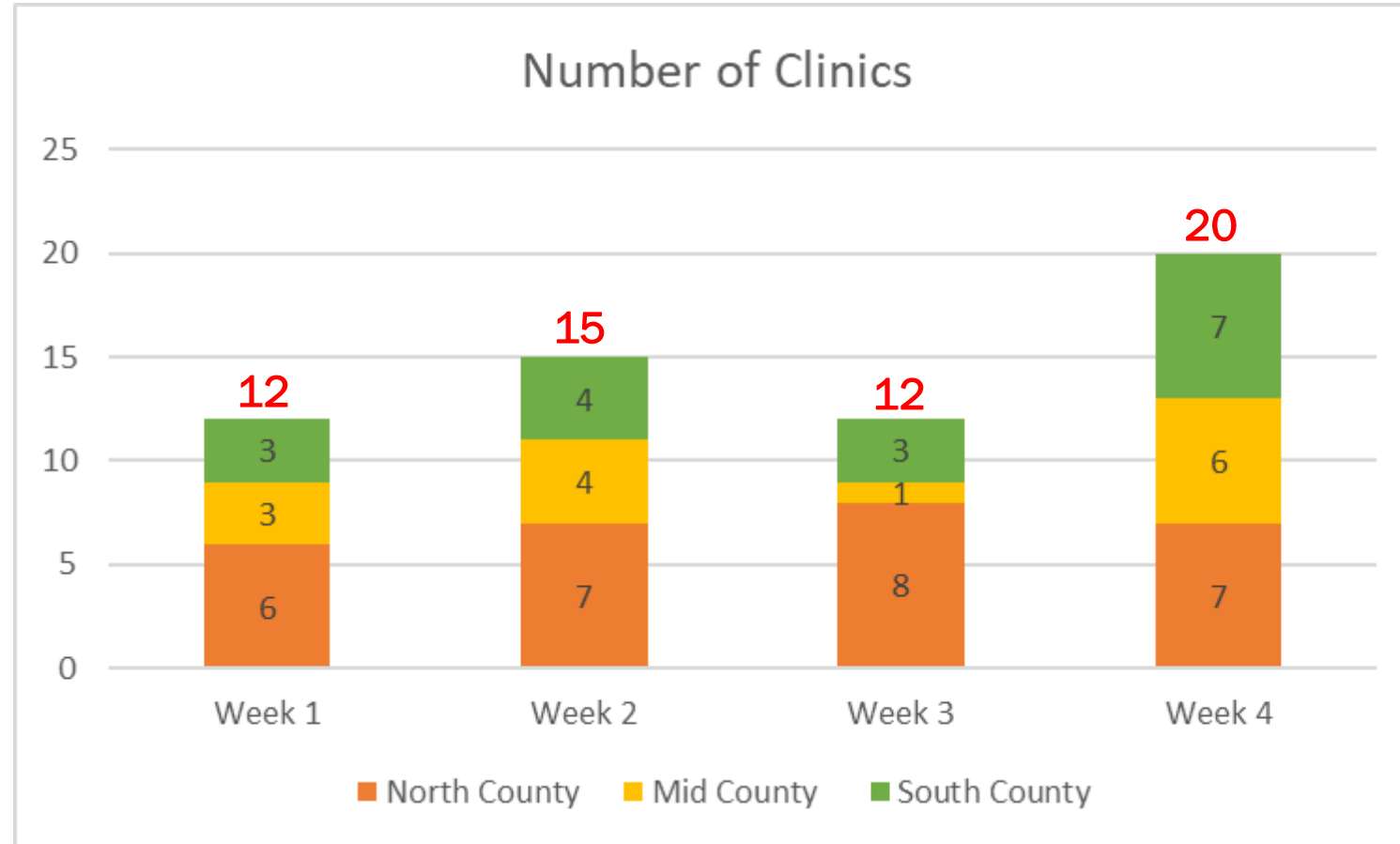

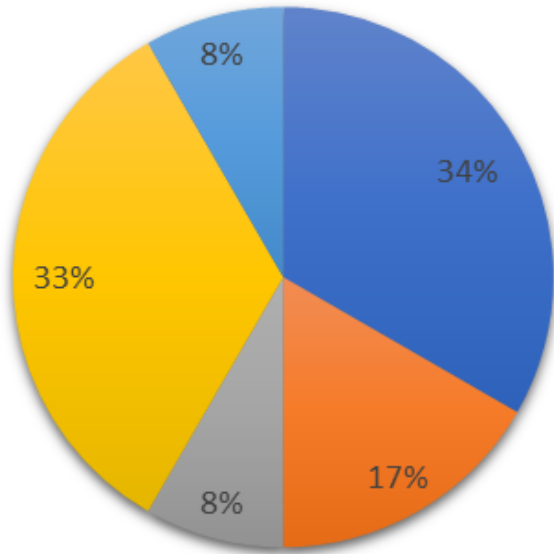


Mobile Vaccination Program

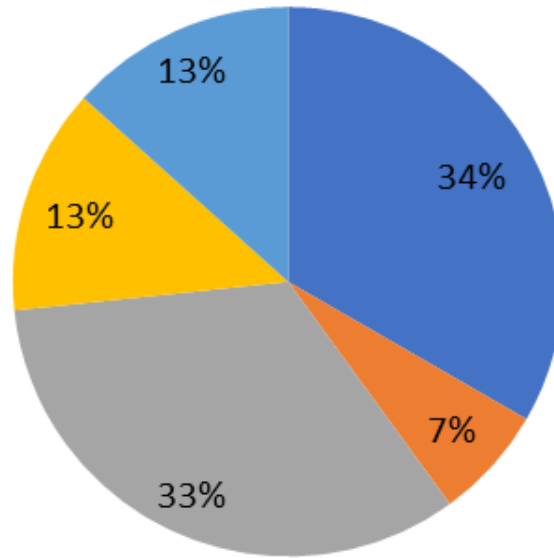


Percent of Mobile Clinics by Sector

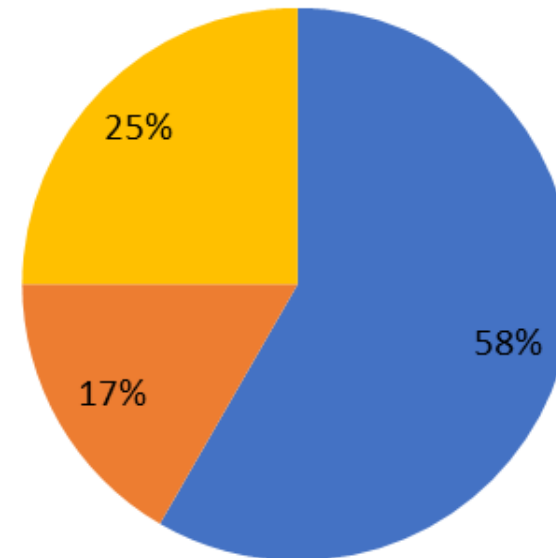

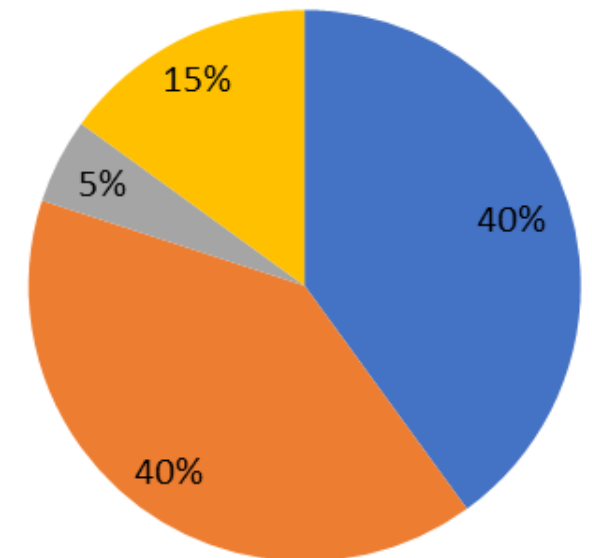
