The activity identified below is determined to be exempt from further environmental review requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970, as defined in the State and County Guidelines for the implementation of CEQA.

Activity Title: Loan of State of California Homeless Emergency Aid Program (HEAP) funds for Mark's House Tiny Homes

Applicant: Good Samaritan Shelter, Inc.

Activity Description:

Good Samaritan Shelter was approved for an award of \$850,000 of State Homeless Emergency Aid Program funds. The County will loan \$196,148 of these funds to Good Samaritan Shelter to assist with its proposed installation of two 400 square foot Tiny Homes units. Each unit will consist of 2 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms, kitchen and living room. The tiny homes would be constructed off-site and delivered to the site to either be placed on piers or sited using integrated metal frames.


