Service Level Reductions

- Agriculture Advisory Committee (\$100,000)
 - Funding for the Ag Advisory Committee would not be available for the committee to initiate projects.
 - This funding has not been spent since is was approved by the Board of Supervisors during FY 2005-06.
 - The AAC can initiate projects through Planning & Development's annual work plan process or by requesting funding directly from the Board of Supervisors.

Agricultural Commissioner – Cooperative Extension

- Service Level Reductions
 - Agricultural Program Specialist Oak Tree Program (\$114,000)
 - The regulatory components of the Oak Tree Ordinance and complaints will continue to be a priority for the department; however, due to the loss of this position, the department will no longer carry out the voluntary planting and educational components.
 - The employee will have an opportunity to move to a vacant Agricultural Biologist position.

Agricultural Commissioner – Cooperative Extension

- Service Level Reductions
 - Clerical position (\$54,274)
 - Eliminate two vacant part-time clerical positions.
