Recommended Action(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve plans and specifications for the project;
- B. Award the construction contract in the amount of \$159,700.00 to the lowest responsible bidder, Sansone Company, 710 Fiero Lane, Suite 21, San Luis Obispo, CA 93401 subject to the provision of documents and certifications, as set forth in the plans and specifications applicable to the project and as required by law.

Summary:

This project involves the installation of a new prefabricated comfort station within Waller Park, Santa Maria. The new building is compliant with current ADA regulations and will include new handicapped accessible concrete sidewalks, new plumbing and electrical connections.

Only one bid was received and opened for the construction project on March 1, 2007. The bid was submitted by Sansone Company of San Luis Obispo, in the amount of \$159,700.00. Parks staff has performed an analysis of the bid and has determined that the bid is reasonable and recommends the award of this contract.

This project was bid in accordance with the Public Contract Code, and is a part of the approved 2006/07 Capital Improvement Program.

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Background:

This new comfort station will be located in Waller Park within walking distance of the existing W.O.O.F. Park (unleashed dog park) and adjacent group picnic facilities. Since there is presently no restroom facility near that area, it will be an added convenience for the many users of the W.O.O.F. Park and will also increase services to all park users.
