Recitals

a. Every state and local government agency is required to adopt a “conflict of interest code”. Government Code Section 87300. A conflict of interest code designates the positions within an agency that “involve the making or participation in the making of decisions which may foreseeably have a material effect on any financial interest” of the public official. Government Code Section 87302(a). The designated public officials must periodically disclose certain investments, interests in real property, sources of income, gifts, loans and business positions. The financial disclosures are compiled on Form 700 as required by the Fair Political Practices Act. Government Code Sections 81000 et.seq. Agencies must amend their conflict of interest codes when necessary to add or delete positions and disclosure categories, and the codes must be reviewed at least every two years.

b. On October 3, 1995, the Board of Supervisors directed the Clerk-Recorder-Assessor to adopt a comprehensive conflict of interest code that would cover multiple agencies. (Resolution No. 95-450). On December 5, 1995 the Clerk-Recorder-Assessor adopted a comprehensive code for County Departments, certain County related Commissions/Boards/Committees and Dependent

Special Districts. This conflict of interest code became known as the “Single Comprehensive Conflict of Interest Code for County Departments, Commissions/Boards/Committees and Dependent Special Districts” (“Single Code”). The Single Code is intended to help ensure timely amendments and revisions. Additionally, all financial disclosure statements (Form 700’s) are filed in the Office of the Clerk-Recorder-Assessor, which provides a central repository for public access. The Board of Supervisors is the “code reviewing body” for the Single Code. Government Code Section 87303.

c. As the code reviewing body, the Board of Supervisors approved the initial Single Code and has approved several amendments to the Single Code that were initially adopted by the Clerk-Recorder-Assessor. The amendments have added and deleted agencies, and revised the list of designated positions and disclosure categories.

d. The 2010-2011 Amendments to the Single Code, are part of the required biennial review.

e. The attached 2010-2011 Biennial Amendments to the Single Code were initially made by the individual member agencies and then adopted by the Clerk-Recorder-Assessor. The amendments impact the identity of designated positions, required reporting categories and some clerical revisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that:

1) The 2010-2011 Biennial Amendments to the Santa Barbara County Single Comprehensive Conflict of Interest Code for County Departments, Commissions/Boards/Committees and Dependent Special Districts (Attachment A) which have been adopted by the Clerk-Recorder-Assessor are approved as 2010-2011 Biennial Amendments to Resolution No. 95-450.

2) All other provisions of Resolution 95-450, as periodically amended, that are not affected by this amendment remain in effect.



2010-11 BIENNIAL AMENDMENTS
TO THE SANTA BARBARA COUNTY
SINGLE COMPREHENSIVE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE
FOR COUNTY DEPARTMENTS, COMMISSIONS/BOARDS/COMMITTEES
AND DEPENDENT SPECIAL DISTRICTS (SINGLE CODE)

- (1) The Political Reform Act, Government Code § 81000 et seq., requires state and local agencies to adopt and amend, as circumstances require, conflict of interest codes. A conflict of interest code designates the positions within an agency that “involve the making or participation in the making of decisions which may foreseeably have a material effect on any financial interest” of the public official. Government Code Section 87302(a). The designated public officials must periodically disclose certain investments, interests in real property, sources of income, gifts, loans and business positions. The financial disclosures are compiled on Form 700 as mandated by the Fair Political Practices Act. Agencies must amend their conflict of interest codes when necessary to add or delete positions and disclosure categories, and at a minimum a conflict of interest code must be reviewed every two years.
- (2) On October 3, 1995, the Board of Supervisors directed the County Clerk-Recorder¹ to adopt a comprehensive conflict of interest code for county departments, certain county related commissions/boards/committees and dependent special districts. (Resolution No. 95-450). On December 5, 1995 the Clerk-Recorder-Assessor adopted a comprehensive conflict of interest code for multiple agencies. This conflict of interest code became known as the “Santa Barbara County Comprehensive Conflict of Interest Code for County Departments, Commissions/Boards/Committees and Dependent Special Districts” (“Single Code”). The Single Code is intended to help ensure timely amendments and revisions. Additionally, all financial disclosure statements (Form 700’s) are filed in the Office of the Clerk-Recorder-Assessor, which provides a central repository for public access. The Board of Supervisors is the “code reviewing body” for the Single Code. Government Code Section 87303.
- (3) There have been several amendments to the Single Code, which have added and/or deleted agencies, and revised the list of designated positions and disclosure categories. These amendments were first adopted by the Clerk-Recorder-Assessor and then approved by the Board of Supervisors as amendments to Resolution No. 95-450.
- (4) The 2010-11 Biennial Amendments to the Santa Barbara County Single Comprehensive Conflict of Interest Code for County Departments, Commissions/Boards/Committees and Dependent Special Districts (Single Code) are adopted as set forth below (the corresponding exhibits are attached):

¹ Subsequently, the Clerk-Recorder was consolidated with the Assessor and is currently the Clerk-Recorder-Assessor.

- a) Exhibit No. C-2, the Human Services Commission for the purpose of revising the titles of existing positions;
- b) Exhibit No. C-3, the Santa Barbara County Housing and Community Development Department for the purpose designating new positions and revising the titles of existing positions;
- c) Exhibit No. C-4, the Santa Barbara County Laguna Sanitation District for the purpose revising the titles of existing positions;
- d) Exhibit No. C-6, the Santa Barbara County Department of Child Support Services for the purpose of revising the titles of existing positions;
- e) Exhibit No. C-11, the Santa Barbara County Clerk of the Board is deleted from Exhibit No. C-11 and this Exhibit will be left blank for future use. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is now a Division of the County Executive Office and is no longer a Department. As such, designated employees listed on Exhibit C-11 are no longer applicable. The position of Chief Deputy Clerk of the Board of Supervisors (Enterprise Leader Classification) is now included as a designated position in the County Executive Office.
- f) Exhibit No. C-12, the Santa Barbara County Clerk, Recorder and Assessor for the purpose of simplifying the existing classification titles, as well as, adding and deleting classifications;
- g) Exhibit No. C-13, the Santa Barbara County Counsel for the purpose of designating new positions;
- h) Exhibit No. C-15, the Santa Barbara County Employees' Retirement System is deleted from the Code and this Exhibit will be left blank for future use. The Santa Barbara County Employees' Retirement System has adopted its own separate conflicts of interest code.
- i) Exhibit No. C-16, the Santa Barbara County General Services Department for the purpose of revising the titles of existing positions and deleting titles to positions that have been abolished;
- j) Exhibit No. C-17, the Santa Barbara County Public Health Department for the purpose of revising the titles of existing positions and deleting titles to positions that have been abolished;
- k) Exhibit No. C-20, the Santa Barbara County Alcohol Drug and Mental Health Services for the purpose of revising disclosure categories, revising the titles of existing positions and deleting titles to positions that have been abolished;
- l) Exhibit No. C-21, the Santa Barbara County Executive Office for the purpose of designating new positions, deleting positions that manage public investments, revising the titles of existing positions and deleting titles to positions that have been abolished;
- m) Exhibit No. C-24, the Santa Barbara County Parks Department for the purpose of revising the titles of existing positions;
- n) Exhibit No. C-25, the Santa Barbara County Human Resources Department for the purpose designating new positions and deleting duplicate positions;
- o) Exhibit No. C-27, the Santa Barbara County Planning and Development Department for the purpose designating new positions and deleting abolished positions;


- p) Exhibit No. C-28, the Santa Barbara County Probation Department for the purpose of revising the titles of existing positions;
- q) Exhibit No. C-30-A, the Santa Barbara County Public Works Department for the purpose of revising the titles of existing positions;
- r) Exhibit No. C-30-B, the Santa Barbara County Flood Control & Water Conservation District for the purpose of revising the titles of existing positions;
- s) Exhibit No. C-30-C, the Santa Barbara County Water Agency for the purpose of revising the titles of existing positions;
- t) Exhibit No. C-31-A, the Santa Barbara County Sheriff/Coroner Department for the purpose designating new positions;
- u) Exhibit No. C-31-B, the Santa Barbara County Fire Department for the purpose of deleting a position that now reports on Exhibit C-21 (County Executive Office);
- v) Exhibit No. C-32, the Santa Barbara County Social Services Department for the purpose designating new positions and deleting abolished positions;
- w) Exhibit No. C-34, the Redevelopment Agency of the County of Santa Barbara for the purpose of designating new positions, revising the titles of existing positions and deleting titles to positions that have been abolished;
- x) Exhibit No. C-36, the In-Home Care Network, Santa Barbara County for the purpose of revising the titles of existing positions;
- y) Exhibit No. C-37, the Workforce Investment Board for the purpose of revising the titles of existing positions;

(5) The other provisions of the Single Code that are not covered by Paragraph 4 of these amendments remain in effect.

(6) Designated employees who are identified in the series C Exhibits attached to the Single Code, shall file original statements of economic interest with the Elections Division of the Office of the Clerk-Recorder-Assessor at 4440-A Calle Real, Santa Barbara, California 93110, or at such other location as is hereinafter designated by the Clerk-Recorder-Assessor.

(7) A copy of the Single Code maybe obtained at the Elections Division of the Office of the Clerk-Recorder-Assessor at 130 E. Victoria Street, Santa Barbara, California 93110.
