# ORDINANCE NO. 5223

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

AMENDING CHAPTER 20 JUVENILES OF THE SANTA BARBARA COUNTY CODE TO REPEAL ARTICLE III SECTIONS 20-9 THROUGH 20-13 AND ARTICLE IV SECTIONS 20-14 THROUGH 20-16.

WHEREAS, the California Constitution authorizes a county to make and enforce local ordinances that do not conflict with general laws; and

WHEREAS, periodically, an administrative clean up of the Santa Barbara County Code is necessary to ensure it accurately reflects current county operations; and

**WHEREAS**, neither the Los Prietos Boys Camp nor the Counseling and Education Centers are operational; and

WHEREAS, County of Santa Barbara Probation Department proposes that outdated language in Santa Barbara County Code Chapter 20, Articles III and IV is repealed.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara ordains as follows:

### SECTION 1: ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE III.

Santa Barbara County Code Chapter 20, titled Juveniles, Article III Los Prietos Boys Camp, sections 20-9 through 20-13 is hereby repealed on the effective date of this ordinance.

The repeal of Santa Barbara County Code Chapter 20, Article III, sections 20-9 through 20-13 shall not have any effect on any criminal or civil litigation or claims, including any claims for fees, arising under said Article and shall not operate as an abatement of any criminal or civil action or proceeding, whether pending before or filed after the effective date of this ordinance.

## SECTION 2: ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE IV.

Santa Barbara County Code Chapter 20, titled Juveniles, Article IV Counseling and Educational Centers, sections 20-14 through 20-16 is hereby repealed on the effective date of this ordinance.

The repeal of Santa Barbara County Code Chapter 20, Article IV, sections 20-14 through 20-16 shall not have any effect on any criminal or civil litigation or claims, including any claims for fees, arising under said Article and shall not operate as an abatement of any criminal or civil action or proceeding, whether pending before or filed after the effective date of this ordinance.

### **SECTION 3: PARTS NOT EFFECTIVE.**

Except as amended by this Ordinance, the Santa Barbara County Code shall remain unchanged and shall continue in full force and effect.

### **SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY.**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Supervisor hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared invalid.

## **SECTION 5: PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Ordinance shall take effect and become operative 30 days from the date of its adoption by the Board of Supervisors. In compliance with Government Code section 25124, within 15 days after its passage, a summary of the ordinance shall be published once, together with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the same in the Santa Barbara Independent, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Santa Barbara.
