SUBJECT: Proposition 40 Grant Funds Authorizing Resolutions

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve a resolution authorizing Santa Barbara County Parks to apply for grant funds under the Roberti-Z'Berg-Harris Urban Open Space and Recreation Program under the California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2002 and appoint the Director of Parks as applicant and agent of the County of Santa Barbara to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements, and payment requests which may be necessary for the completion of project(s).
- B. Approve a resolution authorizing Santa Barbara County Parks to apply for grant funds under the Per Capita Grant Program under the California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2002 and appoint the Director of Parks as applicant and agent of the County of Santa Barbara to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements, and payment requests which may be necessary for the completion of project(s).

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan: The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No. 5.A High Quality of Life for All Residents.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

On March 5, 2002, California voters passed Proposition 40 or "California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002" (2002 Resources Bond). This Bond Act provides \$2.6 billion to conserve natural resources (land, air, water), acquire and improve state and local parks, and preserve historical and cultural resources.

Prop 40 also includes a direct allocation program to Counties, Cities and qualifying special districts. The State Department of Parks and Recreation has prepared allocations under both the Per Capita Grant Program and the Roberti Z'Berg-Harris at approximately \$1.83 million for the County of Santa Barbara.

Your Board has authorized, to date, \$1.05 million of these funds towards partnership projects with the City of Lompoc (Aquatic Center), City of Solvang (Alamo Pintado Triangle Park) and the City of Goleta (Acquisition and Development of Old Town Park). The balance of these funds will be used towards other County projects approved by your Board in November 2002 (refer to attached project list).

These resolutions will complete the grant process and secure the funds allocated to the County as required by the State of California. Both of the direct allocation grant programs under Proposition 40 require that the applicant's governing body adopt a resolution. The resolution is a requirement in order to set up the appropriation of these grant funds under a contract agreement between the State and County. The resolution approves the filing of an application for the funds, certifies that adequate funds are or will be available for operation and maintenance of funded projects, certifies that the County agrees to the General Provisions within the grant program procedural guide and appoints the Director of Parks as agent and applicant for the County of Santa Barbara.

Mandates and Service Levels: Resolutions are required by the State of California under the Proposition 40 grant programs. No impact to service levels with this action.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts: No fiscal impact with this action.

- 4. Certifies that the Grantee has or will have available, prior to commencement of any work on a project, the required Match; and
- 5. Certifies that the project conforms to the recreation element of any applicable city or county general plan; and
- 6. Appoints the Director of Parks as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, Applications, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the projects.
