




Patrol Only Responses During COR Off-Duty by Problem Type Suicidal Subject Check the Welfare Persons Crimes - All other

■ Proactive / Follow-up Co-Response Encounter




~80% of the cohort interacted with BWELL services while only 18% of the cohort was arrested in 2020




