RESOLUTION HONORING THE JEWISH FEDERATION OF GREATER SANTA BARBARA FOR ITS PORTRAITS OF SURVIVAL PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, Portraits of Survival: Life Journeys During the Holocaust and Beyond, is a permanent educational exhibit of 38 local Holocaust survivors that has attracted over 8,000 community members, students and educators since its inception in 2003; and

WHEREAS, Portraits of Survival is an educational resource for our community, teaching the values of tolerance and acceptance while understanding their importance through the context of historical events; and

WHEREAS, the Mis Tres Caras program, a 10 week program that encourages at-risk youth to express their life experiences through creative arts, has succeeded in bringing Holocaust Survivors, community volunteers and at-risk youth together in the effort to combat gang-related violence and facilitate a sense of "belonging" for the youth that empowers them to make positive healthy life choices; and

WHEREAS, Mis Tres Caras strives to accomplish its mission through collaborations with other community groups and businesses such as Art from Scrap, Collaborative Communities Foundation, CORE, Daniel Bryant Youth and Family Treatment Center and Life Chronicles all of whom are working to meet the needs of our youth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors and commends the Jewish Federation of Santa Barbara for its Portraits of Survival programs.
