Priorities for Subsidized Child Development Funding Santa Barbara County

Priorities for State Preschool, Full-Day Preschool, General Child Care, Wrap-Around Care, School-Age Programs and Migrant Programs

Priority 1:

- * School attendance boundaries where 50-100% of enrolled children are eligible for Free or Reduced Lunch.
- * For funding other than through a competitive RFA, any existing contractor in good standing with the ability to expand, regardless of zip code or school boundary, shall be Priority 1.
- * When funds are available through a competitive RFA, seventy-five percent of new funding shall be designated for existing contractors headquartered and currently doing business in Santa Barbara County and in good standing, with the ability to expand. Application for such funds should not be competitive and should be an abbreviated application process.
- * When funds are available through a competitive RFA, twenty-five percent of new funding shall be designated for new applicants headquartered and currently doing business in Santa Barbara County.

The balance of remaining funds to be offered through an RFA to any program that is currently operating and headquartered in any zip code in Santa Barbara County.
