SUBJECT: Construction of 2000/2001 Measure 'D' Asphalt Concrete Overlay, Project No. 810471, First, Second and Third Supervisorial Districts

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Review and approve the Statement of Final Quantities for work performed and materials supplied for this project by the Contractor, Granite Construction Company (a local vendor), in the amount of \$1,849,436.39.
- B. Accept Notice of Completion and authorize Clerk to record.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

This project was an asphalt concrete overlay consisting of removing and repairing failed areas in the existing pavement, cold planing, pavement reinforcing fabric and placement of a Type B asphalt concrete overlay over an asphalt concrete leveling course. Approximately 21 lane miles of County maintained roadway was resurfaced with the construction of this project.

This project was completed on time and under the contract budget amount.
