WHEREAS, Chuck Slosser has been named as a recipient of the Anti-Defamation League 2008 Distinguished Community Service Award; and

WHEREAS, Chuck Slosser completed his undergraduate work in political science at Valparaiso University in Indiana and received a Ph.D. in history from the University of California at Los Angeles; and

WHEREAS, Chuck Slosser has served as Chief Executive Officer for the Santa Barbara Foundation since 1991 growing the Foundation's assets during the past seventeen years from just over \$30 million to a current excess of \$300 million; and

WHEREAS, prior to his distinguished service with the Santa Barbara Foundation, Chuck was the Director of Development for the Santa Barbara Museum of Natural History and Director of Corporate and Foundation Relations at Pepperdine University and UCSB; and

WHEREAS, Chuck also has devoted his time and energies to memberships on the Planned Giving Roundtable, The Foundation Roundtable, the League of California Community Foundations, and the City of Santa Barbara's Long Term Strategy Steering Committee on Youth Violence as well as serving on the boards for the Hutton Foundation and the Orfalea Fund;
