Her efforts included serving on the Franklin School PTA, volunteering in the 1960's to assist teaching English to Spanish speaking students and in later years she participated in the reading program at Franklin Clinic to help—bi-lingual students improve their literacy skills; and

WHEREAS, Marie Mackey has been honored by the San Marcos High School PTA and Athletic Department for her many years of service to the students and faculty where she is also she is fondly known as the "Popcorn Lady" since she always ran the popcorn machine during home football games; and

WHEREAS, Marie Mackey has worked to promote athletics and the benefits good sportsmanship brings to our youth as demonstrated through her involvement with the Goleta Valley South Little League where she served as Team Mom, Auxiliary President, District President and ran the concession stand which was named in her honor; and

WHEREAS, since 1996 Marie Mackey has warmly greeted and provided information to locals and tourist alike as a docent for the County Courthouse. Her duties include giving tours of the Courthouse, giving law experience tours and working the information booths at both the Figueroa Annex and the Main Courthouse. She is especially proud in mentioning the role her father had in the construction of the main arch and the tile work on the spiral staircase; and

Whereas, Marie Mackey generously supports our troops in Iraq and Afghanistan by sending them care packages on a monthly basis;
