#### **Recommended Actions:**

Adopt a resolution authorizing staff to apply for the fiscal year 2010-2011 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) providing grant funding for emergency management activities in the Santa Barbara Operational Area by the Office of Emergency Services.

#### **Summary Text:**

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) provides funding to local jurisdictions to assist with the costs of providing emergency management. FEMA provides this funding through a block grant to the California Emergency Management Agency (Cal EMA- formally the Governor's Office of Emergency Services) for distribution to Operational Areas. The Operational Area is, by statue, managed through the County and includes all political subdivisions of the State within County.

The recommended action authorizes the Office of Emergency Services to apply for the grant. The resolution further identifies those persons who are authorized to execute the grant and submit the required quarterly reports. The EMPG Program funding ensures compliance with state and federal emergency management requirements. The funding provides up to one half of the personnel expense for authorized emergency planning staff, indirect costs, and some services and supplies. This resolution updates Resolution 05-109.

## Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

This resolution allows County OES to apply for reimbursement claims under the EMPG sub grant program through CalEMA. The EMPG Program provides partial funding (up to one half the salary and benefits, depending on funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency) for OES. These funds may also be used to provide equipment or supplies to enhance emergency management throughout the Operational Area. Through discussions with Cal EMA, and based on past grant performance, the amount received through this grant has increased \$39,482 for FY 2010-2011 is \$199,482.43. The term of the EMPG is July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011.

Budgeted: Yes. The EMPG funding is included in the department's 2010-2011 proposed budget.
