**Strategic budget decisions can reduce incarceration, improve fairness,  
protect public safety, and save money —all at the same time.**

Santa Barbara County's criminal justice system embodies several dysfunctions that increase costs and drive unnecessary jail use. Prudent, targeted "balancing" and "restoration" budgeting decisions will address key problems, improve justice, and save money.

**PROBLEM 1) Court delays keep people in jail longer than necessary, at great cost.** A 2025 *California Public Defense Workloads and Staffing* study documents significant **caseload and staffing disparities between the Public Defender and District Attorney that create a serious choke point for criminal justice and lengthen the stays of people in our jails.** Length of stay is a primary driver of jail population.

Public Defender understaffing results in too few attorneys and investigators having overwhelming caseloads. Excessive caseloads slow case processing after arraignment by delaying investigations of contested facts and preparation of defenses. Acknowledging systemic necessity, judges routinely grant continuances "for good cause."

The astonishing result of this dysfunction is that **70% of those in our jails, about 525 of the average daily population (ADP), wait for their cases to move**

**forward at a cost of \$394 per person per day<sup>1</sup>** Just 30% of those currently in our jails are actually convicted and sentenced.

The human and financial costs of this systemic dysfunction is, to some degree, self-inflicted because our County has chronically under-funded the Public Defender. We pay dearly for systemic delays through elevated jail costs and D.A. and P.D. attorneys' time for repeated continuances. Accused persons pay dearly by remaining jailed while their cases remain unresolved.

**Problem 1 Budget Solutions:**

**A. Reduce the necessity for post-arraignment “just cause” delays by adding two Public Defender investigators (\$153,000 for 1; \$305,000 for 2), plus two entry level lawyers (\$167,000 each).<sup>2</sup>** Adding just a couple staff will reduce caseload pressures, enabling timely attention and improved efficiencies.

The total cost to do this, up to \$639,000, can be covered by restoring to the Public Defender part of the \$759,720 currently earmarked as a balancing measure. Alternatively, funding could come from rebalancing the Sheriff's Office custodial operations to achieve cost savings; or limiting the Northern Branch Jail expansion to 1 Housing Unit, as discussed below.

**Cost savings: Reducing court delays will streamline case resolutions, lower the Average Daily jail Population (ADP) and improve justice.** Evidence from other jurisdictions confirms common sense: manageable caseloads speed case processing and reduce days in jail for those whose cases are undecided:

- Sacramento County: average jail stay reduced from ~54 to ~40 days
- Dane County, WI: 7–14 days faster processing resulted in up to 20% jail reduction;
- A 10% reduction in delays for Santa Barbara County could **lower ADP by about 75.**

**B. Approve CCP's recommendation to expand the public defender's pre-arraignment early representation (READY) program to the South County jail.** In the Northern Branch Jail (NBJ), pre-arraignment early access to READY clients results in faster case resolutions and client outcomes that average 48% fewer days in jail compared to those who do not receive early representation.

**Cost savings:** This evidence-based recommendation will be funded with Credo-V funds that are already available. **The current READY program in the Northern Branch Jail (NBJ) has reduced the ADP by 14.** Extending the READY program to

South County is expected to reduce the ADP in South County by up to **14** beds. Currently, only 50% of eligible READY clients in the NBJ currently receive early pre-arraignment representation. Future READY funding could reduce ADP in the NBJ by an additional **14**.

A study of the Santa Barbara READY program shows a clear cost-saving benefit.: an investment of \$110,000 in READY (1 social work mitigation specialist) saves the County about \$250,000 by reducing the average number of required jail beds.<sup>3</sup>

**PROBLEM 2: People who are Court-approved for treatment remain in our jails.** In the last 72 days, 33 jail residents were Court-approved for release to mental health or substance use treatment, subject to bed availability. They remained jailed an average of 24 days because appropriate treatment beds are unavailable. This is a continuous, revolving problem. At a cost of \$394 per person per day to remain housed in jail, the current delays cost \$312,048.

**Problem 2 budget solution: Expand treatment alternatives to incarceration.** Support State Proposition 1 grants and other funding for additional community-based mental health and substance use treatment to accommodate the stream of those in jail who receive Court-approval for release into such care.

**Cost savings:** Grant-funded treatment facilities will help reduce the average daily jail population of roughly 30-40 people who are Court-approved for release upon bed availability but remain in jail for lack of available treatment facilities.

**PROBLEM 3: Sheriff's Office Custodial Operations costs are unchecked, and the Sheriff's discretionary law enforcement policies elevate jail ADPs.**

**A. Costs for the Sheriff's Custodial Operations are unchecked.** From 2014-2024, Santa Barbara's average daily jail population (ADP) declined from 966 to 750. During that same period, Sheriff's custodial staff increased by more than 90 FTEs, from 251 to 353. The current FY budget *just for jail operations*, is \$107,780,000, not including cost overruns.

In 2020, our County hired outside consultant KPMG to provide an independent review of County criminal justice departments. See KPMG County Sheriff's report: [County of Santa Barbara - File #: 21-00141](#); see, also, KPMG's interagency report. [County of Santa Barbara - File #: 21-00140](#).

KPMG's examination of Custodial Operations found "variable costs account for roughly 15- 25 percent of the overall Custody Operations budget...". But, KPMG noted, "cost avoidance... will only be realized in full if population reductions enable the closing of units or reduction in staff." KPMG *Countywide operational performance review*, October 2020, p. 57.

Since KPMG's review, entire units of the South County jail have closed (solitary confinement cells, medium security barracks, as well as other areas of the Main Jail). The NBJ, now in operation for more than two years, is designed for lower staff-to-resident ratios. Despite these changes *and* a significantly reduced jail population, custodial operations costs continue to soar.

**Solution: Apply balancing measures to the Sheriff's custodial operations.**

There are no balancing proposals relating to custodial operations. With Supervisor oversight, prudence and rebalancing, the custodial operations budget can be better managed.

KPMG's findings and recommendations focus on key management issues such as overtime spending and overuse of sworn peace officers for tasks civilian staff could safely manage. KPMG's careful study provides a means for Supervisors to identify management shortfalls and apply justifiable balancing measures.

**B. The Sheriff's discretionary law enforcement policies result in higher-than-average arrest rates that are a significant driver of unnecessary jail use.** The Sheriff's Office provides county-wide law enforcement. Overall crime rates have fallen over the past 10 years.<sup>4</sup> **Yet, Santa Barbara County's 2024 adult arrest rate of 3,214.1 per 100,000 population is 33% higher than the statewide average of 2,440 adults per 100,000 population.**<sup>5</sup> Focusing on misdemeanor arrests, peer Counties - - San Luis Obispo and Ventura - - annually average about 1000 fewer arrests per 100,000 residents, 25%-35% less than Santa Barbara County.<sup>6</sup> Our District Attorney's office declines to file approximately 33% of referred misdemeanor arrests, yet those arrests still result in jail bookings and short stays that increase ADP. **Zealous arrest policies keep law enforcement and custodial staff busy, and require D.A. staffing to screen unsupportable cases, at significant expense but with little impact on public safety.**

**If our County's adult arrest rates were in line with state averages, approximately 774 fewer arrests would occur annually, with a similar reduction in those booked in and out of our jails. This should reduce the need for custodial intake staffing.**

**We ask Supervisors to review arrest policies with the Sheriff's Office.** Collaborative law enforcement policies and practices in tune with other jurisdictions could help decrease our jails' ADP without compromising public safety.

**C. Don't overfund jail expansion. Approve construction of 1 Housing Unit (256 beds) rather than 1½ Housing Units (384 beds) for the Northing Branch Jail.**

Streamlining and diversion strategies described above will safely reduce jail demand. This is already starting to happen. Apply prudent judgment to cancel or defer ½ Housing Unit, future jail capacity that will never be needed as diversion strategies gain traction and delay dysfunctions are addressed. Save up to \$147 million in long-term construction, financing and operating costs – money the county can deploy for essential community services.

**In summary, strategic budget decisions can reduce incarceration, improve fairness, protect public safety, and save money—all at the same time.** At its core, this is good stewardship and caring governance at work. People currently remain in jail due to delays - not risk. Individuals with mental illness wait in custody for Court-ordered release to treatment beds. Low-level arrests disrupt jobs, housing, and families. The human impact of our current system, as well as cost-saving strategies, must help guide your decisions.

Building new federal detention centers has become a hot-button issue in immigration policy. Expanding our own jail beyond necessity is out of step with many in our community who feel essential services should receive funding priority.

As our community has become educated about our criminal justice system, many organizations and faith communities endorse limited jail expansion, as evidenced by endorsements and signatures on a Petition to Limit Funding to Just One Housing Unit at Santa Barbara County's North Branch Jail (submitted separately as Public Comment).

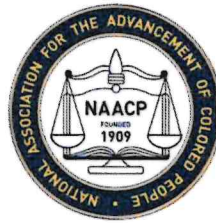

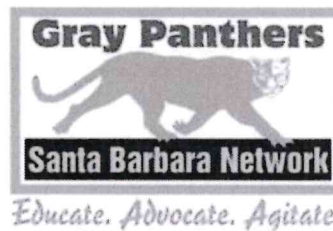

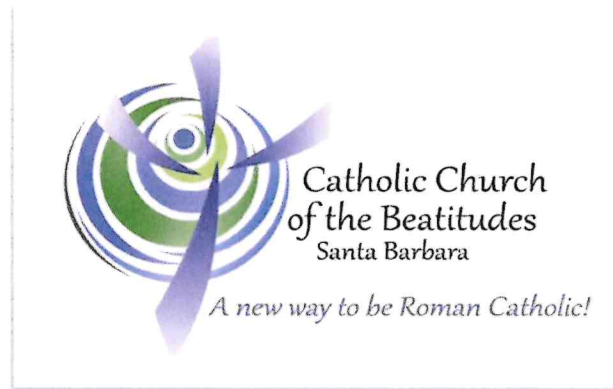
