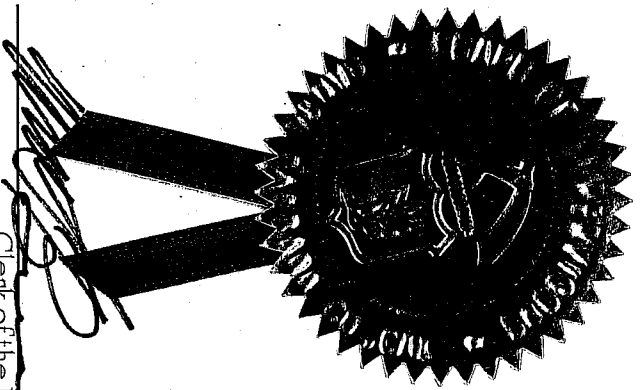
WHEREAS, Santa Maria Elks Lodge No. 1538 will sponsor an observance during the week in tribute to the junior citizens of the local community; and
