Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an Agreement with Kingdom Causes, Inc. dba City Net (local vendor) to provide training for Understanding & Responding to Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children for a total contract amount not to exceed \$4,400 for the period of January 14, 2025 through January 14, 2026; and
- b) Determine that the activity is not a "Project" subject to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) review per CEQA Guideline Section 15378(b)(5), since the activity is an organizational or administrative activity of government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda in order to approve the Agreement with Kingdom Causes, Inc. dba City Net (City Net) to provide training for Understanding & Responding to Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (CSEC) for a total contract amount not to exceed \$4,400 for the period from January 14, 2025 through January 14, 2026. The training is designed specifically for social workers and paraprofessionals in child welfare settings. The goal is to provide comprehensive training needs that meet the mandatory CSEC requirements.

This item is on the agenda, as this contract in combination with other contracts in aggregate will exceed the \$200,000 threshold with City Net for our County.

Background:

City Net provides a foundational understanding of Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children. Participants will learn about the definitions, local & national prevalence, and risk factors associated with CSEC. The training covers the impact of trauma on youth, the dynamics of exploitation, the roles of various stakeholders in prevention and intervention, and highlights the critical role social workers play in prevention and intervention. Attendees will learn to adopt a trauma-informed approach, equipping them to better support and advocate for children.
