- b) Find that the A-Street Basin Weir Structure Reconstruction Project is Maintenance and Repair of an Existing Facility with no expansion of the existing use and that the project is therefore exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301, and direct the Clerk of the Board to post the attached Notice of Exemption.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda in order to authorize the Public Works Director to advertise and receive bids for the A-Street Basin Weir Structure Reconstruction Project.

This project will reconstruct the weir structure of the A-Street Basin that is located in the City of Santa Maria. The concrete channel weir and inlet structure has reached the end of its useful service life. There have been many repair projects, both routine and emergency, after storm damages in the past. The concrete has significantly deteriorated and the most cost effective option is to reconstruct.

Background:

The A-Street Basin is located within the City of Santa Maria and is a part of the Orcutt Regional Recharge Project constructed in the early 1980s. The A-Street Basin Weir Structure Reconstruction Project is scheduled for the fall of 2020.
