- B. Award the construction contract in the amount of \$663,351.20 to the lowest responsible bidder, All American Asphalt, a California corporation (Not A Local Vendor), P.O. Box 2229, Corona, California 92878-2229, subject to the provisions of documents and certification, as set forth in the plans and specifications applicable to the project and as required by law:
- C. Authorize the chair to execute the construction contract upon return of the Contractor's executed contract documents and the review and approval of the County Counsel, Auditor Controller and Risk Manager or their authorized representatives:
- D. Approve a contingency fund in the amount of \$45,667.56 for the Construction of 2004/2005 Measure 'D' Preventive Maintenance Application of Slurry Seal in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Supervisorial Districts of Santa Barbara County, County Project No. 820516.

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
Executive Summary and Discussion:

On Thursday, September 9, 2004, five (5) bids were opened for the Construction of 2004/2005 Measure 'D' Preventive Maintenance Application of Slurry Seal in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Supervisorial Districts of Santa Barbara County, County Project No. 820516. All American Asphalt, a California corporation, submitted the lowest responsible bid in the amount of \$663,351.20, which was 18% below the Engineer's Estimate. The difference in the Engineer's Estimate and the lowest responsible bid can be attributed to the number of competitive bids received and the volume of work to be performed as compared to the other recent preventive maintenance work that has been advertised. Staff has performed an analysis of the bids received and has determined that the low bid is responsible and reasonable. Staff recommends awarding this contract to All American Asphalt.

The project is one of the strategies the Department employs in its annual Preventive Maintenance Program and consists of the application of a slurry seal coat on the existing pavement surface at various locations throughout Santa Barbara County. Approximately 56 lane miles of County maintained roadway will be resurfaced with construction of this project.

Your Board approved the project as part of the 2004/2005 Capital Improvement Plan. The specific project locations were approved by your Board in the FY 2004/2005 Road Maintenance Annual Plan (RdMap) and attached for your information.

This project was bid in accordance with the Public Contract Code, which requires the award to the lowest responsible bidder.
