That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Accept a grant of \$10,000 from the California Highway Patrol (CHP) for increased law enforcement to reduce driving under the influence and related alcohol violations.
- b) Approve Budget Revision 2007008 recognizing the grant revenue and appropriating expenditures within the Santa Barbara Sheriff's Department.

Summary Text:

The California Highway Patrol Office in Santa Barbara has been awarded a grant from the State Office of Traffic Safety to provide enhanced levels of law enforcement on crime related to driving under the influence (DUI) and related alcohol violations. The specific area identified for enforcement is the area within and around the community of Isla Vista and around the University of California at Santa Barbara (UCSB). The Sheriff's Department has been awarded \$10,000 of this grant to provide services to meet the objectives. Sheriff's deputies, on overtime, will be used to conduct extra patrolling of the identified area with the focus being on DUI and alcohol enforcement.

<u>Background</u>: The California Highway Patrol has recognized an increase in DUI traffic accidents where drivers were either injured or killed within the corridor to UCSB. To that end they have applied for and received a DUI College Corridor Grant from the State Office of Traffic Safety. A portion of this grant has been allocated to allied agencies for DUI and related alcohol violation enforcement. The Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Department has been identified as one of these allied agencies.
