SUBJECT: Sole Source Procurement of MechoShades from Diversified Window Coverings, Inc.

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors authorize the sole source procurement of two MechoShades, motorized shade equipment, from Diversified Window Coverings Incorporated, (not a local vendor), in an amount of \$75,600, without being required to comply with the formal bid process.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

This recommendation is primarily aligned with actions required by law or routine business necessity.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The installation of a motorized skylight shade has been requested by the Clerk-Recorder-Assessor to help mitigate for the intensity of natural light now penetrating the recently restored Hall of Records. In determining who could fabricate and install such a device, it became clear that very few companies specialize in large shade equipment installation. After a three month search, Diversified Window Coverings, Inc. was the only company to respond to our request for information and pricing. The Support Services Division is requesting sole source authorization for the following reasons:

- The size of the shade (25 feet by 25 feet) is too large for local vendors to provide.
- There are only three vendors in southern California certified to install a MechoShade and no local vendors.
- Other manufacturers' equipment will not provide the flexibility and sun-block protection that the MechoShade product provides.
