SUBJECT: Extend a No Parking Zone on Ward Drive in the Goleta Area.

Second Supervisorial District.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

C.A. Recommendation:

That the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution which will supercede Resolution 81-318 extending the No Parking zone north of Ekwill Street in the Goleta area.

ALIGNMENT WITH BOARD STRATEGIC PLAN:

The recommendation is primarily aligned with Goal #2: Ensure the public health and safety and provide essential infrastructure.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY & DISCUSSION:

A request was received from the Second District Supervisor's Office to extend the No Parking zone at 600 Ward Drive. Due to the current 40 mph speed limit on Ward Drive, the sight distance for motorists leaving an industrial complex onto Ward Drive will improve by restricting additional parking in this area.

The Public Works Department recommends the establishment of an extension to the no parking zone for the purpose of improving sight distance and in the interest of public safety at the following location:

On the east side of Ward Drive from a point 484 feet north of the centerline of Ekwill Street to a point 693 feet north of the centerline of Ekwill Street.

MANDATES & SERVICE LEVELS:

No mandates or service levels are affected by this action.

FACILITIES AND FISCAL IMPACT:

Approximately \$100.00 will be required and is available in Department 054/02/04 Account #7121 for red curb installation.
