IN THE MATTER OF THE ZACA FIRE
AND THE BOARD'S CONTINUING
CONCERNS

RESOLUTION NO. 07 – _____

WHEREAS, from August 3, 2007, to November 20, 2007, the County of Santa Barbara and the jurisdictions therein, have remained under a local proclamation of a State of Emergency due to the to the Zaca Fire; and

WHEREAS, staff from the County of Santa Barbara and other political subdivisions have taken actions, to the extent feasible, in an attempt to protect the citizens and properties within the County from impacts to the watershed and other factors associated with the Zaca Fire; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors remains concerned over potential watershed impacts to the citizens of Santa Barbara County from the Zaca Fire, and therefore directs staff to continue to interact with local, state and federal representatives in staffs' efforts to reduce and prevent impacts from the Zaca Fire; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors directs staff to maintain a state of readiness in anticipation of the impacts from flooding, silt and debris as a result of the Zaca Fire; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors believes that continuing a proclamation has no further benefit in preparation of winter impacts that may occur.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara, that the proclamation of the local emergency that was made by this Board by Resolution 07 – 227, and subsequently reaffirmed, is hereby terminated and directs the Emergency Operations Chief to communicate to the State Office of Emergency Services said termination.
