That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Accept a \$30,000 cash donation from the Edgecomb Foundation to be used to purchase a Dodge Charger vehicle for use by the DARE program Deputies in the execution of their duties, and
- 2) Approve Budget Revision #2007257 recognizing the donation and appropriating the expenditure.

Summary Text:

The Edgecomb Foundation has presented to the Sheriff's Department a check for \$30,000.00 for the purchase of a vehicle. The Dodge Charger will be used by the DARE deputies going to the various schools for their training sessions.

Background:

The Edgecomb Foundation is a California Non-Profit Public Benefit Corporation organized for charitible purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

The DARE program is taught by two Deputy Sheriffs, one in the North County and one in the South. Numerous schools throughout the County are participating in the program. In addition to DARE, the Deputies also teach Lifeskills classes.

Budget revision #2007257 recognizes the donation revenue and is offset by a like amount in LI 8300, Fixed Assets. This vehicle will be accounted for as an operating cost vehicle, whereby all expenses incurred in the operation and maintenance will be directly charged to the department. The Sheriff's Department anticipates that the vehicle will cost about \$1,500 per year to operate and is covered by existing budget as it replaces an existing operating cost vehicle that will be going out of service.
