### **Summary:**

On Thursday, September 28, 2006, two (2) bids were opened for the Construction of 2005/2006 TEA-21 Representative Lois Capps Demonstration Project Surface Treatment in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Supervisorial District of Santa Barbara County, County Project Number 862260. The lowest responsive bid was submitted by Granite Construction Company, (a local vendor, with an office in Santa Barbara), a California Corporation, in the amount of \$549,682.00, which is 10.3 % over the Engineer's Estimate. It was determined that the additional cost was due to the requirement that the work at the intersection of Hollister and Turnpike be done at night for the public's safety and convenience. Public Works staff has performed an analysis of the bid received and has determined that the bid is responsive and reasonable and recommends awarding this contract to Granite Construction Company.

The proposed project is located in the unincorporated area west of the City of Santa Barbara and will resurface one and a quarter (1.25) lane miles of Hollister Avenue from Modoc Road to 2,200 linear feet West of Modoc Road. The construction will consist of the repairs of failed pavement areas and placement of a Type B asphalt concrete overlay over a Stress Absorbing Membrane Interlayer (SAMI) and asphalt concrete leveling course.

The second location is the intersection of Hollister Avenue and Turnpike Road. The construction of the intersection will consist of 0.20' average full width grind and placement of a Type B asphalt concrete overlay over pavement reinforcing fabric and asphalt concrete leveling course.

This project was bid in accordance with the Public Contract Code, which requires the award to the lowest responsive bidder.



# **Background:**

The specific project location was approved by your Board in FY 2006/07 Road Maintenance Annual Plan (RdMap) on March 28, 2006, and is part of the 2004 State Transportation Improvement Program Roadway Rehabilitation Project for which the County received partial funding for in Fiscal Year 2005/06.
