SUBJECT: Establishing Bicycle Parking Zones in the Third Supervisorial District

Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Adopt the attached Resolution (Attachment A) to establish bicycle parking zones in the Third Supervisorial District; and
- b) Determine the proposed action is exempt from the provisions of California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to 14 CCR 15301(c) (as the proposed project(s) consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing, including but not limited to existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities), and approve the filing of the attached Notice of Exemption on that basis.

Summary Text:

This item is on the agenda to establish bicycle parking zones on various roads in Isla Vista to allow designated bicycle parking in the right of way. Bikeshare and electric scooter organizations are now operating across California, providing the public with convenient alternative transportation. In order to operate most efficiently, they often use public spaces for parking. A bikeshare company called CycleHop was recently selected by UCSB to begin operating on campus and in Isla Vista at the end of August. The Public Works Department, with input from CycleHop, determined suitable sites in Isla Vista to create designated bicycle parking locations. These locations were chosen based on convenience for bicyclists and public safety. Locations were also chosen that would preserve current vehicle parking and free movement for pedestrians and vehicles. Although CycleHop is currently the only bikeshare organization operating in Isla Vista, these locations will be available to the public and any other bikeshare organization for bicycle parking. Public Works will return to your Board at a later date to consider exclusive use areas, similar to the outdoor dining program, for bicycles and other vehicles that may operate in the road right of way.

Proposed Parking Zones

Pursuant to County Code 23-11 and California Vehicle Code Section 22508, the Board of Supervisors, by Resolution may regulate vehicle parking on certain streets. This action would designate the locations listed in the Resolution (Attachment A) and shown in the Vicinity Maps (Attachment B) as bicycle parking.

The Public Works Department prepared the attached Resolution to adopt the designated bicycle parking at the following locations:

Third District – Unincorporated Area in Isla Vista

ADOPT

“Designated Bicycle Parking” Zones

- On the sidewalk located on the north side of Pardall Road adjacent to the curb, a 14’Lx6’W box and 16’Lx6’W box, beginning 60’ west of the centerline of Embarcadero del Mar, separated by a 5’ length between the two boxes.
- On the sidewalk located on the north side of Pardall Road adjacent to the curb, a 24’Lx6’W box, beginning 52’ west of the centerline of Embarcadero Del Norte.
- On the west side of Camino Del Sur, a 30’Lx8’W box, beginning 55’ south of the centerline of Berkshire Terrace, just north of Picasso Road.
- On the north side of Sueno Road at Sueno Park, a 47’Lx8’W box, beginning 486’ west of the centerline of Camino Pescadero.
- On the south side of Del Playa Drive, a 20’6”Lx8’W box, beginning 486’ east of the centerline of El Embarcadero at Pelican Park.

Background:

Parking restrictions are established based on safety, necessity, and community benefit. Public Works weighs all of these factors and presents any recommended changes to your Board for approval. These parking restrictions may include, but are not limited to “No Stopping, Standing, or Parking”, “Time Limited” parking, “Loading” zones, “Vehicle Height Restricted” parking, “Angle” parking, “Handicapped” parking, delineated parking with white paint, or any combination of restrictions.

Public Works has surveyed the proposed designated bicycle parking zone locations described in this Board Letter, and found it to be in the best interest of the community and the traveling public to establish the proposed designated bicycle parking zones. Public Works recommends your Board’s approval of the attached Resolution to implement designated bicycle parking zones, and determine this action is exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), pursuant to 14 CCR 15301(c).
