Speed Limits

- > State law sets maximum speed limits
 - Criteria for speed zones are established by the California Vehicle Code (CVC)
- Local agencies can set speed limit zones by Engineering and Traffic Surveys (ETS)
 - The CVC approved methodology for ETSs is established by Caltrans
- ETS's are valid for up to 10 years
- Enforcement on County roads is performed by the CHP
- Establishing a speed zone by ETS enables CHP enforcement with tools such as radar

Process

- ETS is performed
- ETS results presented the County Traffic Engineering Committee (TEC)
- TEC recommendations are presented to the Board of Supervisors
- Board amends County Code by ordinance to designate speed limit zone(s)
- Appropriate signage and roadway markings are installed
- Documentation is provided to the CHP for enforcement






