





The Contractor's attention is directed to the information presented below and to the attached pages that contain modifications to the Notice to Contractors, Special Provisions (Book), Proposal and Contract (Example) (Book) and Plans to clarify the information presented, provide additional information or provide changes to the design. The following paragraphs describe the modifications to the Contract Documents (*Notice to Contractors, and Special Provisions and/or Proposal and Contract (Example), and/or the Plans*).

TO ALL BIDDERS

1) SPECIAL PROVISIONS

A) SECTION 4. BEGINNING OF WORK, TIME OF COMPLETION, AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES IS MODIFIED AS FOLLOWS:

CHANGE PARAGRAPH 2 AS FOLLOWS:

The Contractor shall begin work on the first working day following the expiration of 20 calendar days after the contract has been awarded by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara, in no case shall the Contractor begin work later than **APRIL 23, 2012**, and shall diligently prosecute the same to completion within the time limit provided in these Special Provisions. The Contractor may upon written request begin work earlier than the first working day following the expiration of the 20th calendar day after the contract has been awarded, subject to conditions set by the County and approved in writing by the Director of Public Works.

The Contractor shall proceed to begin work on the first working day even without an executed contract in his possession upon such direction, either written or verbal, from the County.

The Contractor shall diligently prosecute the work to completion before the expiration of **ONE HUNDRED TWENTY (120) Working Days**.

SITE WORK HOURS – Allowable site work hours pursuant to the site permits are Monday through Saturday, 6:00 AM to 8:00 PM, and 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM on Sunday. Work outside these hours is not allowed. The contractor is responsible for securing the locks on the landfill entrance gate for those allowable site work hours beyond the Site Operation hours (7:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday and 7:00 AM to 2:00 PM on Saturdays). Should there be any incident of the gate being left unlocked by the Contractor or Subcontractor, the Contractor shall provide a person to continuously watch the gate for those hours beyond the Site Operation hours or the Contractor shall limit his work hours to those of Site Operation hours.

B) 5-1.27 HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT– The following is added to the second paragraph of 7-1.01D Vehicle Code of the Standard Specifications:

Paragraph 2:

“Attention is directed to the statement in Vehicle Code Section 591 that this section shall not relieve the Contractor or any person from the duty of exercising due care. The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions for safe operation of the Contractor's equipment and the protection of the public from injury and damage from the Contractor's equipment.”

Addition – Paragraph 3:

The contractor shall provide a copy of the most recent Equipment Safety Checklist records for each piece of construction equipment in operation at the site, as required per 10-1.16 of the project specifications, to the Construction Manager each week. Said records shall not be older than 3 working days. If at any time during construction the construction manager observes unsafe operation due to unsafe equipment and requests the most recent Equipment Safety Checklist records for a specific piece of equipment the contractor shall provide by the close of business that same day. The Construction Manager can request that the piece of equipment be taken out of service until a review of the Equipment Safety Checklist record for the specific equipment at no additional cost to the contract for equipment down time.

C) Add the Following **SECTION 10-1.15 - Diesel Fuel Price Adjustment**

SECTION 10-1.15 - Diesel Fuel Price Adjustment

Recent volatility in the price of diesel fuel has made estimations of equipment rates more difficult. In order to allow the contractor (or the Owner) to recover extra expenses due to significant fluctuations in diesel fuel costs, the Owner will pay the contractor for significant increases in fuel consumption costs. Conversely, should diesel fuel prices fall significantly during the contract period, the contractor will provide the Owner with a credit. The method for determining the payment is as follows.

Payments (or credits) will be based on fluctuations from a baseline price. The baseline price will be the spot price for Ultra-Low Sulfur No. 2 Diesel Fuel in Los Angeles, CA, the day of the project bid opening, as reported on the US Department of Energy, Energy Information Administration (EIA) web site (Weekly Petroleum Status Report – DOE/EIA) currently shown on Table 12 of the Report:

Should the monthly average diesel price as reported on the above website increase more than forty (40) cents from the baseline price, the contractor may submit a request for supplemental payment. The payment to the contractor for supplemental payment for the specific monthly progress payment requested will be equal to the number of gallons of diesel consumed during the calendar month in question, based on fuel delivery receipts, multiplied by the per gallon increase in average monthly spot diesel price as obtained on the aforementioned web site. Should diesel prices fall to more than 40 cents less than the baseline price, the Owner will request a credit from the contractor. The credit is calculated in the same manner.

MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Diesel Fuel Price Adjustment - Item No. 2C

The Diesel Fuel Price Adjustment Calculation shall be calculated based on Section 10-1.15 above, and the payment to the contractor will be equal to the number of gallons of diesel consumed during the calendar month in question, based on fuel delivery receipts, multiplied by the per gallon increase in average monthly spot diesel price as obtained on the indicated web site.

3) CONTRACTOR QUESTIONS: All contractor questions shall be submitted in writing to the County Construction Manager (Travis Spier) via e-mail: tspier@cosbpw.net . All contractor questions are due at the close of business on March 1, 2012; this will be the final day for contractor questions.

The following was the only contractor question received as of the Addendum 1 Date:

- Question:** According to Section 4 of the Special Provisions (p.14) it states that:
- The contractor shall complete the work within (120) working days.
 - Sequence 1 work shall be completed within 75 working days.
 - Sequence 2 work shall be completed within 120 working days.

Meanwhile on (p. 66) of the Special provision it states that:

- Sequence 1 work shall be completed within (60) working days from the start date.
- Sequence 2 work shall be completed within (90) working days from the start date.

Please clarify.

Answer: The following paragraphs within 10-1.19 EARTHWORK are modified as follows:

Project Sequencing Plan –Sequence of Earthwork/Phase IIIA Construction Project Work

The following sequence of work shall be used for the Contractor's preparation of the Project Sequencing Plan; the following sequence of Earthwork/Phase IIIA Construction Project Work is required:

- Assess, determine, and incorporate scheduling/sequencing restrictions pursuant to the requirements of the Biological Mitigation Measures required under Paragraph 10-6.01 of these specifications.
- Clear and grub as specified in Paragraph 10-1.17 CLEARING AND GRUBBING: removal of unsuitable material.
- Excavate from the west borrow area, transport material to the Fill Berm Area, Phase IIIA Base Liner 2-foot Low Permeability material subgrade, and the South Channel Fill Area (west borrow soil material shall be placed no closer than 2-feet from bottom of channel section); Place and Compact to the line and grades indicated on the drawings
- Blasting, unclassified excavation as required to bring the proposed subgrade for the Phase IIIA Liner Area to the line and grades indicated on the Drawings; stockpile excavated soil in the north stockpile area.
- Perform Unclassified Excavation of Drainage fill material adjacent to the Phase IIC liner area; transport excavated soil to the daily cover stockpile.
- Process Low-Permeability material from the North Stockpile area for use as base liner low permeability material for Phase IIIA; construct test pad; continue with Phase IIIA low-permeability material placement, Liner Construction (geosynthetics, LCRS system, and protective soil cover), and record drawing surveying.
- Complete Bid Schedule Sequence 1 work (Liner Excavation, West Borrow, Berm Fill, and Phase IIIA Liner work) and provide beneficial occupancy to COUNTY before the expiration of **seventy-five (75)** working days from start date.
- Perform Balance of Excavation, removal of unsuitable material, installation of Canyon Subdrain and North Channel Fill to the line and grades indicated on the Drawings (Note screened material to be placed within 2-feet of the channel section); continue blasting, and unclassified excavation required to bring the Balance of Excavation to the line and grades indicated on the Drawings; stockpile excavated soil in the north stockpile area.
- Complete Bid Schedule Sequence 2 work including all Channel Work, North Borrow Area, and Stockpile work before the expiration of **one-hundred twenty (120)** working days from start date.

4) MODIFICATION TO PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS – 10-1.21 GEOSYNTHETIC CLAY LINER

GCL Conformance Sampling, Testing, and Reporting

The Contractor shall obtain all conformance samples directly from the manufacturing plant, under the observation of the Engineer, or as approved by the Engineer, pursuant to Section 2.3. Samples shall be taken across the entire width of the roll and shall not include the first three feet. Unless otherwise specified, samples shall be 3 feet long by the roll width. The Engineer shall mark the machine direction on the samples with an arrow, and the Liner Manufacturer's roll identification number.

At a minimum, conformance tests will include determination of the following characteristics for the GCL:




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

The following were the **only** additional contractor questions received prior to the March 2, 2012 2:00 PM Contractor question deadline:

1) **Question:** We are trying to understand the spec for the unclassified fill for south channel fill, berm fill, and North Channel file. Is all fill up to 2' below finish need to be 3" minus and top 2' be 1" minus select fill?

Answer: All fill within two feet below the Bottom of Channel Section is to be 1-inch minus select fill.

2) **Question:** If all unclassified fills needs to be 3" minus the time frame to screen all this material will not be adequate. Will the schedule be extended?

Answer: To clarify unclassified fill for the South Channel area, the unclassified fill from the West Borrow area has been used previously. Based on ripping and some processing of the excavation by the Contractor, no screening of the material has been necessary to meet the 3-inch minus specification. The unclassified fill in the North Channel area (below the two feet of select screened 1-inch minus material where the concrete channel will be placed) will be from blasted excavation areas. The Contractor will need to work with his blasting subcontractor and will need to do some select grading in order to meet the 3-inch minus material specification for the North Channel area. There will be no extra payment for this work, nor will there be any schedule extension.

3) **Question:** Is the contractor expected to hydroseed areas shown in the SWPPP figures under bid item #2B?

Answer: It is expected that all BMP's required by the SWPPP, except Hydroseeding, be included in the Lump Sum Bid amount for Item 2B. Should the County choose, select areas will be hydro-seeded. The hydroseed work will be performed on a time and materials basis if required.
