

Background

- County Animal Services provides mandated rabies clinics weekly in Santa Maria and periodically throughout the County.
- CA Department of Public Health recently raised the recommended rabies vaccination fee from \$6 to \$10.
- Recommendation: increase Santa Barbara County fee for rabies vaccination to \$10.



Fiscal Analysis

- Estimated to increase revenue by \$8,000 annually
- State-recommended “actual cost” may not be full cost recovery
- Does not affect mandates or service levels



Recommended Actions

- That the Board of Supervisors:
 - **Approve** the introduction of an Ordinance amending the fee for rabies vaccinations on July 11, 2017
 - **Waive** full reading of the Ordinance
 - **Continue** the Fee Ordinance for second reading on July 18, 2017
 - Determine above actions are organizational and administrative activities of government that are **not a project under CEQA**
