RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution establishing a Handicapped Parking Zone on Sagunto Street in the Santa Ynez area.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY & DISCUSSION

Sagunto Street between Edison Street and Meadowvale Lane is one of the main collector roads running east/west through downtown Santa Ynez. The road consists of two travel lanes with on-street angle parking and businesses fronting both sides of the street. A request was made for the installation of a handicapped parking stall on Sagunto Street near the intersection of Edison Street. Based on a field investigation it was determined by the Public Works Department that a handicapped parking zone could be accommodated at the following location:

- On the south side of Sagunto Street from a point 52 feet east of the centerline of Edison Street to a point 78 feet east of Edison Street.

In accordance with the American Disabilities Act (ADA), the handicapped parking zone will consist of a parking stall (min. 9' 0" wide) and a loading and unloading zone (min. 5' 0" wide) located on the passenger side of the vehicle for persons with disabilities.

MANDATES & SERVICE LEVELS

No mandates or service levels are affected by this action.

FACILITIES AND FISCAL IMPACT

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Approximately \$400.00 will be required and is available in Department #054\02\04, and Account # 7121 for the sign installation and pavement marking.
