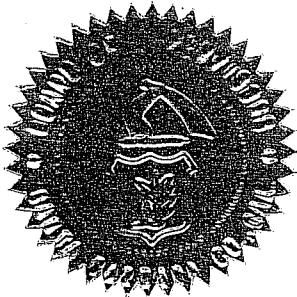
WHEREAS, the UNA-USA Santa Barbara County Chapter is a volunteer organization that was founded in 1947 and is the second oldest chapter in the United States; and
