A revised Budget is attached (1 Pages), which replaces the Budget in the original Agreement, and is incorporated into the Agreement effective July 1, 2023.

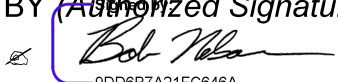
The addendum to the Scope of Work is required because they want to add a contractor and move money around to pay for the contractor.

Scope of Work - Addendum

Amendment 02 as of 5/06/26

Santa Barbara County Department of Agriculture/Weights and Measures

I. Project Plan

Weed Species to be Controlled: Invasive species rated as A, B or Q by CDFA or on the CCR 4500 Noxious Weeds list.

Methodology: The CDFA Noxious Weed Grant funds will control and ultimately eliminate the invasive Cape Ivy (*Delairea odorata*) which poses a threat to native habitat and monarch resources. This will support an ongoing effort, the Ellwood Monarch Butterfly Habitat Management Plan, for which environmental review has been completed. The associated CEQA document is available at <https://ceqanet.lci.ca.gov/2019011059/3>.

Secondary project goals include the control and elimination of Algerian Ivy (*Hedera canariensis*), Pampas grass (*Cortaderia jubata*) and Italian thistle (*Carduus pycnocephalus*) from the area. Cape Ivy, Pampas grass and Italian thistle are all rated “W” under the CDFA rating system and are included in the CDFA Noxious Weed list. If additional invasive species are encountered during the project, those will be addressed as grant funds allow.

The University of California Santa Barbara Cheadle Center in coordination with the City of Goleta, will map the extent of current populations of Cape Ivy in the winter/spring when the species is most visible. In the Spring, field crews will conduct hand removal of invasive species. The next round of mapping will occur in February 2027 to document progress on invasive plant control and assess effectiveness of the control efforts.

During Cape Ivy control and mapping work, populations of secondary weeds will be noted with points, and follow-up weeding will be implemented later in the spring and summer as appropriate for the species.

By October 15, 2026, a report documenting weed extent in Spring 2026 and invasive plant control work for all species will be submitted to the County. This will include uploading GIS data to State maps per instructions. In 2027 a similar cycle of events will take place to follow up on 2026 work and address any new invasive plants identified during the 2026 or 2027 monitoring. A final report will be completed by January 31, 2028.

All information will be shared with CDFA as per instructions. The County will remain the primary applicant throughout the grant. County staff will assist with administrative duties, plant identification and Cal Flora mapping.

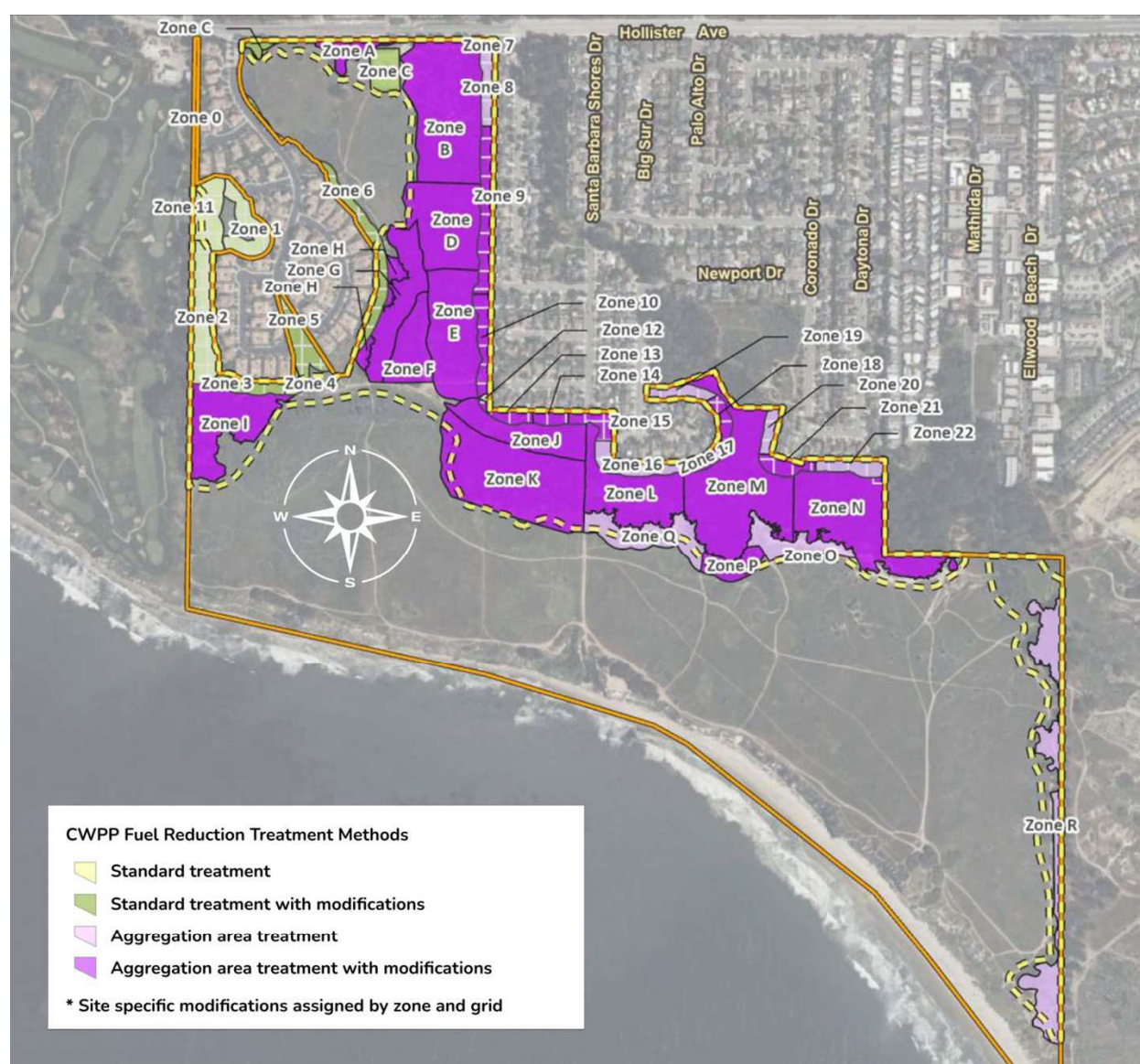


Figure 1. Ellwood Mesa boundaries – orange and dashed orange/pale yellow lines.

Location(s): County of Santa Barbara. The work will be focused on the Ellwood Mesa and Monarch Grove areas located within the City of Goleta. See figure 1 below.

Weed Removal/Control Techniques(s): Weed abatement work will be through the use of hand pulling and removal.

II. Reporting

Grant recipients will be required to submit a mid-year report to CDFA documenting a visual representation of the project's progress on October 15, 2026, and October 15, 2027.

Final project reports are required 30 days after project completion, no later than January 31, 2028. Final project reports should include detailed information on project results and include photos of field work showing progress (before/after photos).
