SUBJECT: Amendment to the Conflict of Interest Code of the Lompoc Unified School District

Recommended Actions:

- a) That the Board of Supervisors approves the attached proposed amendments to the Conflict of Interest Code of the Lompoc Unified School District (“District”); and,
- b) Determine that the above action is an organizational or administrative activity of government that is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to section 15378(b)(5) of the CEQA Guidelines.

Summary Text:

The District’s Conflict of Interest Code amendments were adopted November 13, 2018. The amendments include the revision of titles of existing positions; and the deletion of positions that have been abolished and/or positions that no longer make or participate in the making of governmental decisions. (See Attachment A – 2018 Local Agency Biennial Notice; and Attachment B – Lompoc Unified School District Board Resolution #3144).

Background:

All public agencies are required by the Political Reform Act of 1974 to:

1. Adopt local conflict of interest codes identifying the reporting requirements of covered employees; and,
2. Review the need for any revisions to their local conflict of interest codes on a biennial basis.

The Political Reform Act designates Boards of Supervisors as the local Code Reviewing Body for independent districts and agencies. The revised Conflict of Interest Code is effective once approved by your Board.
