Recommended Actions:

Consider recommendations regarding amendments to renew contracts for Alcohol and Drug Program Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) services for FY 08-09, as follows:

- 1. Approve and execute an amendment to the contract with Aegis Medical Systems, Inc. (not a local vendor) to continue providing DMC Narcotic Treatment Program Services for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 in the amount of \$900,000.
- 2. Approve and execute an amendment to the contract with Good Samaritan Shelter, Inc. (a local vendor) to continue providing DMC Treatment Services for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 in the amount of \$250,000.
- 3. Authorize the Director of ADMHS to approve amendments to the proposed contracts, provided that any such amendments do not exceed ten percent (10%) of each contract's dollar amount.

Summary Text:

The State Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs allocates state and federal revenue to counties for the provision of substance abuse prevention and treatment services, and provides reimbursement to counties for such services. In accepting state or federal funds earmarked for alcohol and drug program services, counties are obligated to comply with federal and state laws, regulations, and administrative policies specified as a condition of the receipt of funds. The vendors for which contract amendments/renewals are proposed provide Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) alcohol and other substance abuse

treatment services, including individual and group counseling, and related services. Approval of the recommended actions will renew the agreements for FY 08-09.

<u>Background</u>: Aegis Medical Systems, Inc. provides methadone prescribed by a physician to alleviate withdrawal symptoms from narcotics. Aegis also conducts urine drug screening and provides individual and group counseling to clients. Services are directed at stabilization and rehabilitation of clients who are opiate addicted and have substance abuse diagnoses. Services are provided at Aegis' locations in Santa Maria and Santa Barbara. Aegis provided DMC treatment services to 698 clients in FY 06-07.

Good Samaritan Shelter, Inc. provides DMC services in Santa Maria, including non-residential drug abuse and alcoholism treatment, recovery, and rehabilitative services including individual and group counseling and support services to Medi-Cal beneficiaries. Additionally, Good Samaritan provides treatment services to women who are pregnant or in the post-partum period, who present with alcohol and/or drug problems, and may have co-occurring mental health or physical disorders. Good Samaritan provided DMC treatment services to 354 clients in FY 06-07.

RPM 0216: to provide alcohol and other drug treatment services to 5,000 adults and youth.
