1. What are you requesting? Describe equipment or other program support. Include brochures or photographs.

We would humbly like to request the purchase of the plastic sphere dispensing drone. Aerial ignitions drones are on the forefront of advancements in wildland firefighting operations. The drones utilize the latest in technologies to provide a bird's eye view with infrared, topographic, and live camera feed. The drone carries a payload of self-igniting plastic spheres that are used in firefighting operations. Generally, the drone is utilized in steep terrain to perform firing operations, keeping firefighters safe.

3. Who will use the equipment or program support?

The plastic sphere dispensing drone will primarily be used by fire department personnel, specifically those involved in wildfire management and prescribed fire operations. The drone will be operated by trained fire crews to disperse plastic spheres—typically fire retardant or chemical agents used in controlled burns or wildfire suppression. These spheres help create firebreaks or slow the spread of fires by igniting in a controlled manner.

Additionally, the drone could also be utilized by emergency response teams involved in managing hazardous materials or environmental protection, where precision dispensing of retardants or other substances is needed.

The use of this drone will enhance safety, efficiency, and effectiveness in fire management while protecting both people and property.

4. Who in our community will be served by this program support?

The PSD drone will serve our community by enhancing both emergency response and prescribed fire management. In addition to improving situational awareness during active fires and search and rescue operations, the drone will be invaluable for conducting prescribed burns. It will allow fire personnel to safely monitor controlled burns, assess fire behavior, and ensure proper execution, minimizing risks to surrounding areas. This support benefits local residents, businesses, and natural resources by ensuring safer, more effective fire management practices, reducing the threat of uncontrolled wildfires, and promoting healthier ecosystems.

5. Why are you requesting this equipment/program through the Alliance rather than your Agency?

The PSD drone cannot be directly budgeted for through our agency due to funding constraints and the specialized nature of the equipment. Our current budget is primarily allocated to essential, ongoing operational expenses such as personnel, training, and basic firefighting tools. Advanced technology like the drone falls outside of our typical annual budget priorities, especially given its high cost and the specialized training required to operate it effectively.

6. How long will the equipment or program support likely be in service?

The training to become fully operational with the PSD drone is expected to take approximately 5-6 months.

7. Is ongoing maintenance for the equipment/program required? If so what are the anticipated costs for maintenance/replacement.

Yes, ongoing maintenance for the PSD drone is required to ensure that it remains operational, safe, and effective for fire department use. Regular maintenance helps prevent malfunctions, extends the life of the equipment, and ensures it remains compliant with any regulatory standards. The county will cover the ongoing expenses associated with this equipment.

Payment for equipment purchases can only be made to the manufacturer or vendor. We will not write reimbursement checks to Santa Barbara City Fire, The City of Santa Barbara, Santa Barbara County Fire or the County of Santa Barbara.

The Recipient Agency is Responsible for Maintenance of the Equipment:

Once the equipment is purchased and donated to the recipient agency, that agency is responsible for all costs associated with the parts, supplies and maintenance required to keep the donated equipment in working order.

## Equipment Must be Purchased Within 6 Months of Board Approval Date:

Equipment approved for purchase must be ordered within <u>6 months</u> of Board approval date. This can be extended by Board review and approval. Any monies approved by the Board which are not spent within 6 months will revert back to the SBFA General Appropriations Fund and be "Available for Appropriation" to future City Fire or County Fire funding requests. Any unspent funds will <u>not</u> be held specifically available for the agency originally granted the fund request unless an exception is requested and approved in advance by the SBFA Board of Directors.
