AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING PARTS OF THE EARLIER ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 4694, WHICH APPROVED DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENTS FOR INLAND AND COASTAL AREAS OF THE SANTA BARBARA RANCH PROJECT PURSUANT TO SECTION 35.86.040, OF CHAPTER 35, ZONING, OF THE SANTA BARBARA CODE

Case Nos. 03ORD-00000-00012 and 03ORD-00000-00013

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara ordains as follows:

SECTION 1:

Ordinance No. 4694 was adopted by the Board of Supervisors on October 21, 2008, and conditionally approved separate Development Agreements for inland and coastal portions of the Santa Barbara Ranch Project, Case Nos. 03ORD-00000-00012 and 03ORD-00000-00013, respectively (“SBR Development Agreements”).

SECTION 2:

Ordinance No. 4694 also granted the owners of Dos Pueblos Ranch the right to apply for a Development Agreement covering those portions of the Santa Barbara Ranch Project that pertain to Dos Pueblos Ranch consisting of Case Nos. 08COC-00000-00001 through 00003, 08LLA-00000-00010 and 00014, 08CUP-00000-00060, 08CDP-00000-00098 through 00101, and 08LUP-00000-00466 subject to, and contingent upon, the owners’ commitment to participate in various actions connected to the SBR Development Agreements.

SECTION 3:

The Santa Barbara Ranch Coastal Development Agreement is not yet effective because the Development Agreement is contingent on final approval by the Coastal Commission of the Santa Barbara Ranch Coastal Plan Amendments.

SECTION 4:

Sections 2, 4 and 5 of Ordinance No. 4694 are hereby rescinded and the previous approval granted for the SBR Development Agreement (Case No. 03ORD-00000-00013), entered into by and between the County of Santa Barbara and Vintage Communities, Inc.; Santa Barbara Ranch, LLC; Vintage Vineyards, LLC; Osgood Farms, LLC; Matthew K. Osgood; DLC Ranch, LLC; TW Family Farm, LLC, for the Coastal Areas of the Santa Barbara Ranch Project is hereby vacated. Furthermore, the rescission of portions of Ordinance No. 4694 hereby void and nullify all rights previously granted to the owners of Dos Pueblos Ranch with regard to applying and

receiving approval for a separate Development Agreement under the terms of Ordinance No. 4694.

SECTION 5:

Before the expiration of 15 days after its passage, a summary of it shall be published once, together with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the same in the Santa Barbara News-Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Santa Barbara.
