Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize the contribution of \$5,000 to North County Rape Crisis and Child Protection Center, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, (EIN # 95-2994637), from the Fifth District General County Programs Department 990 discretionary fund;
- b) Find that the project provides a community benefit that meets the social needs of the County; and
- c) Determine that the above actions are organizational or administrative activities of the government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment and are not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to section 15378(b)(5) of the CEQA Guidelines.

Summary Text:

Upon adoption of the County's FY 2023-24 Budget, each supervisorial office was allocated \$100,000 of discretionary funding to direct toward projects and/or programs in the County in need of funding. These funding requests must be approved by the full Board of Supervisors.

This action will authorize a \$5,000 contribution to North County Rape Crisis and Child Protection Center for education and prevention programs.

Background:

Since 1974, North County Rape Crisis and Child Protection Center has been providing services to vulnerable populations and victims. Their mission is to reduce the incidence of and vulnerability to sexual assault, child abuse and human trafficking by providing education and prevention skills to community children and adults, and to alleviate the trauma experienced by survivors of these crimes by providing direct services.
