- Concern posed by Supervisor Gray for impacts on housing developments under construction
- 11 housing projects in various stages of construction
- 1500 individual homes in foreclosure in entire county

County Actions to Date

- Task Force formed:
 - Building & Safety
 - Code Enforcement
 - Clerk/Assessor
 - Fire
 - Sheriff
 - Public Works
 - County Counsel
 - Housing and Community Development

- Project Inventory construction status, infrastructure, security and bonding availability
- Determination of financial institutions involved in projects
- Residential properties in foreclosure surveyed by Code Enforcement
- Determination of financial institutions backing properties

- County Counsel determination of actions that can be taken to ensure maintenance and security
- Sheriff's Department provide security watch to deter vandalism, inappropriate activities
- Research of best practices from other agencies

- Determination of funding availability from Federal and State sources for acquisition and rehab of foreclosed properties; and for foreclosure counseling
- Competitive process for \$145 million

- Only initial steps taken
- Following inventory of properties,
 better status will be available and a
 determination of how to best proceed
 will be made
