#### **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors appoint First District Supervisor Salud Carbajal and Second District Supervisor Janet Wolf be the County representatives to the South Coast Gang Task Force Leadership Council.

#### **Summary Text:**

The South Coast Gang Task Force has been established to help coordinate the various initiatives on the South Coast that address the issue of youth gang violence. As reflected in the attached diagram, the Leadership Council will consist of elected officials and community leaders and serve to provide oversight and leadership to the Task Force. The Council will: (1) represent a South Coast regional commitment to a five year pilot program to end youth gangs and violence; (2) commit to support the efforts and secure resources to accomplish the mission; (3) call for performance measures to evaluate and continue program funding; (4) focus on ending youth gangs and violence and (5) meet jointly with the Executive Council three times a year to receive reports on program progress and accomplishments.

### **Background:**

On March 17, 2009, the County received a letter from the City of Santa Barbara requesting the County's participation on the South Coast Gang Task Force, including designating Supervisors to represent the County on the Leadership Council of the Task Force (attached).

#### **Performance Measure:**

Performance measures pertaining to ending youth violence and gangs will be established and then used by the Leadership Council to evaluate the effectiveness of programs.
