RE: Consider recommendations regarding Fiscal Year (FY) 2026-2027 Orcutt and Providence Landing Community Facilities Districts Special Tax Levy; Fourth District, as follows:

- iii) Certify the list of all parcels within the County of Santa Barbara Community Facilities District No. 2002-1 (Orcutt Community Plan) subject to the Special Tax Levy including the amount of the tax to be levied on each parcel for FY 2026-2027 and direct the Clerk of the Board or other designated official to file with the County Auditor the certified list;
- iv) Certify the list of all parcels within the County of Santa Barbara Community Facilities District No. 2004-1 (Providence Landing) subject to the Special Tax Levy including the amount of the tax to be levied on each parcel for FY 2026-2027 and direct the Clerk of the Board or other designated official to file with the County Auditor the certified list; and
- v) Determine that the above recommended actions are not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guideline Sections 15378(b)(4) and 15378(b)(5) because the actions consist of organizational or administrative actions that will have no direct physical impact on the environment and the creation of government funding mechanisms or other government fiscal activities



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which do not involve any commitment to any specific project.
