Authorize the Chair of the Board of Directors to:

- A. Approve the attached <u>Notice of Exemption</u> pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines regarding the proposed acceptance of fee ownership of the parcel known as APN 117-030-098 which parcel is located adjacent to the Blosser Flood Control Channel in Santa Maria; and
- B. Execute the Certificate of Acceptance attached to the Grant Deed regarding the above referenced property.

Summary Text:

The property being granted to the County is known as APNs 117-030-098, (herein the "Property") and is owned in fee by the North Preisker Ranch Limited Partnership (herein the "Owners"). The Property is a small unimproved parcel of land located adjacent to the Blosser Flood Control channel in Santa Maria. The Property is of such a size and shape that it can not be used by the current Owners and they desire to give it to Flood Control. Flood Control desires ownership as they can use the Property for access to Blosser Channel and for maintenance operations associated therewith.

Background:

North Preisker Ranch Limited Partnership purchased a large parcel containing the Property in 2002. The North Preisker partnership is in the final stages of home construction and sales on the large parcel and offered the Property to Flood Control free of charge.

The Santa Barbara County Planning Commission at its regular hearing of June 4, 2006 found that acceptance of ownership of the Property by the Flood Control District is in conformity with the County's adopted General Plan.

Performance Measure:

There is no charge for the Property, access to and maintenance of the Blosser channel may be improved by accepting ownership of the Property.
